



2015 Greek Awards Application Packet

Attached you will find the 2015 awards packet. This packet offers information to assist you and your chapter members in completing the awards application. Included are descriptions, criteria and cover sheets for the individual and chapter awards.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Chapters must have a 2.50+ term GPA for the 2015 spring and fall semesters
2. Be free of any social probation or have made appropriate restitution as determined by the Associate Director of Student Life
3. Be in good financial standing with IFC, PHC or NPHC and have attended (or been excused from) all events deemed mandatory by IFC, PHC or NPHC since the last Greek Awards program
4. Be in good financial standing with Eastern Kentucky University
5. Must have filed all paperwork (updated all forms) required by the Office of Student Life at the time of application

SUBMISSION DETAILS

A written statement, no more than two (2) pages unless otherwise stated, must be submitted outlining the reasons why their chapter/nominee should be considered for the award. Chapters wishing to include supporting documentation in addition to the written statement may include: newspaper articles, photographs, marketing materials, and letters of recommendation/support from faculty/staff, advisors or national officers. Each award may have no more than two (2) pages of supporting documentation unless otherwise noted in the application requirements. Categories requesting letter(s) of recommendation are in addition to the required supporting documentation and should be limited to two (2) pages. Any resume submitted should be limited to three (3) pages.

All submissions must be typed using Times New Roman style, 12-point font with 1.5 spacing and one (1) inch margins. Only events and activities that have taken place between **January 1, 2015** and **December 15, 2015** will be considered in award selections. *All applications become the property of Eastern Kentucky University and will not be returned.*

AWARD CATEGORIES

One (1) winner per council (IFC, NPHC, and Panhellenic) will be selected for each chapter award unless otherwise noted.

INSTRUCTIONS

- All submissions must be typed using Times New Roman style, 12-point font with 1.5 spacing and one (1) inch margins.
- Written statement, **not to exceed two (2) pages**, describing the advisor's role and why he/ she should be chosen.
- Chapters wishing to include supporting documentation may include: newspaper articles, photographs, and letters of support from faculty/staff, advisors or national officers **not to exceed one (1) page**.
- **The written statement & the supporting documentation may not exceed three (3) pages.**
- **No more than three (3) letters of recommendations/support can be included.** These letters should not exceed two (2) pages and should include the name, address, telephone number, and title of person making the recommendation.

QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates cannot have won the award in the last three years.

Note: When considering which advisor to nominate (if you have more than one), chapters should account for service to the chapter at EKU, involvement with the national fraternity/sorority, involvement with the alumni/graduate chapter, assistance/guidance provided during chapter issues, events/activities he/she has participated in with the chapter, as well as overall engagement with the chapter membership.
